Copies extremely slowly from a school board or book?

Holds a pen or pencil with an immature grip?

Demonstrates a marked discrepancy between verbal knowledge and written?

Has continued difficulty with spelling and reading despite their level of intelligence?

These difficulties have been either greatly reduced or are no longer present in children who have followed the INPP schools' programme.

This programme is devised by The Institute for Neuro-Physiological Psychology (INPP), Chester, which was established as a private research, clinical and training organisation in 1975, dedicated to the development of assessment procedures to identify underlying physical factors in specific learning difficulties and to the development of effective remediation programmes. The INPP Schools' Programme is based on a clinical programme that has been in use since the 1970s. The clinical programme has been adapted to be used with groups of children in the form of a simple daily exercise programme, which can be completed in school.

Claire d'Authreau initially studied in Biological Psychology and then Neuro-Developmental Therapy with Sally Goddard Blythe (Director) and Peter Blythe (Founder) of INPP. She runs a Clinic, Developmental Education Programmes, in Jersey. She predominantly works with children with learning difficulties and adults experiencing challenges with sound discrimination, coordination and balance. Claire is an Approved Trainer of the INPP Schools' Programme.
